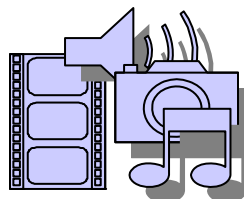

## Featured Service: Requesting Books from Library Locations

See a book in the OSU Library catalog you want?

Click on  to have an item delivered to any OSU library location or to your office (look for My Columbus Campus Office/Dorm). This button will also place a hold on items checked out.

Is the book you want checked out? Click on  to see if another OhioLINK library has it. You can then click on the [REQUEST THIS ITEM](#) link in the OhioLINK record to have an item sent to OSU - OhioLINK items will generally arrive quicker than items checked out from OSU that you place a hold on.

OSU Libraries eReserves is an on-line service that provides web access to course reserves readings via CARMEN, OSU's on-line course management system. All articles are reviewed for copyright compliance before adding to CARMEN. This gives faculty assurance that they are following copyright law.

Instructors and teaching staff using Carmen and even those who do not use Carmen can submit eReserves Content for use in their Carmen course. Just complete the EXCEL spreadsheet on the eReserves webpage and deliver your photocopies to 004 SEL Library, or you can take your materials to any library location and complete an eReserves form. Just ask the Head of Circulation.
