Our Article Express service now provides OSU faculty, staff, and students with **free** electronic delivery of journal articles from both OSU and non-OSU collections.

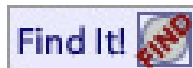
Log on to ILLiad (our online request system) to type in your request, or request articles directly from library research databases by using the Find It! link.

Did You Know? Find It!

Many of our databases allow you to easily check for online access easily via the Find It! Button -



When you click on the button, it checks for online access. If there is no online access, you are shown print holdings and offered a link to interlibrary loan the item. When you click on the interlibrary loan link and log in, the information about the item will automatically be placed in the form - most of the form will be filled out for you!
