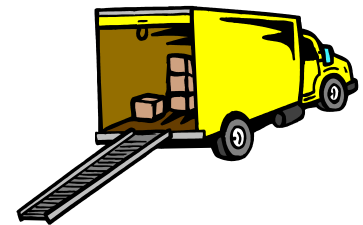

# What's going with the Music/Dance move to SEL?

The Music and Dance Library's staff and its materials will be coming to SEL., Several things will be happening in SEL over the next few months:

- SEL items with overlapping electronic content will be moving to storage.
- Additional compact shelving is being added to the basement.
- The SEL collection will be shifted. A-QA call numbers will be on the 4th floor, QB-Z and Reference will be in the compact shelving. Books and journals will be together, all years within a call number will be together (no more year splits!).
- The Music and Dance Library's materials and staff will be located primarily on the 2nd floor.
- Additional library departments will be taking up space on the 3rd floor.
- Shelving will be placed on the 2nd floor.
- Music/Dance materials will be moved to the 2nd floor.
