

Electronic Journals

The current edition of the CBE Manual does not include style guidelines for electronic journals. However, the publisher (now known as the Council of Science Editors) recommends using the *National Library of Medicine Recommended Formats for Bibliographic Citation* (<http://www.nlm.nih.gov/pubs/formats/internet.pdf>) for guidance in citing electronic resources. In this format, the date a resource is viewed or consulted is part of the citation.

This guide is based on *Scientific Style and Format: The CBE Manual for Authors, Editors, and Publishers* 6th edition, 1994. (T11 S386 1994)

Citation examples are provided in **Name-Year** format.

Bibliography items are listed alphabetically at the end of the research paper. These items are referred to in the body of the paper using the **In-Text** style.

If none of these examples seem appropriate, consult the *CBE Manual* available in the Reference collections of the Biological Sciences/Pharmacy Library; Education, Human Ecology, Psychology, and Social Work Library; Veterinary Medicine Library; and other OSU libraries.
