3. Activities

- Implemented a new wiki page for SAC members to share documents and track projects.
- Revised and implemented a simplified Director's Award nomination form that is available online. Reviewed nominations for the 2011 Director's Award and made recommendations to the Libraries Director.
- o Helped organize, publicize, and gather topics for the quarterly Libraries General Meetings.
- Provided feedback to Libraries Administration and Human Resources on a variety of topics, including:
 - Performance Review Process
 - Proposed Student Employee Recognition Program
 - New Employee Orientation program
- Initiated a pilot project called "Featured" in which individual staff members are the focus of a Q&A in NewsNotes. The purpose is to help staff get to know each other better. The pilot project began in February. As of June 1, six staff members had been featured.
